

MARDI GRAS MASKS

Lesson of the Day:

Sometimes people wear masks so they can do things that they usually wouldn't. They think that if they have a mask on, no one will know it's them. But if you do something bad and don't get caught, you will still know that you did the bad thing. You have to make the choice to do the right thing, whether others will know you made a bad choice or not. Hold yourself accountable for your actions.



Materials:

- Colorful construction paper
- Popsicle sticks
- Paper straws
- Feathers

- Glitter glue
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students trace their hand on a piece of purple, green, or yellow construction paper. Then have them trace their hand on a different colored piece of paper. Have the students cut out the two handprints. Have them glue a popsicle stick to the back of one and the front of the other to make sure the thumbs are on the bottom of both hands on the mask.
- 3. They should decorate their handprints. Have them decorate the back of one so that the thumbs will both be on the bottom when they make their mask. Have them glue feathers on top.
- 4. Have them glue paper straws to the popsicle sticks.
