



NEW YEARS EVE BALL DROP

Lesson of the Day:

Don't drop the ball! Make sure you help hold up and lift those around you and take care of others. You don't want to be part of the reason that someone stumbles and can't get up. So if someone is having a hard time, help them get back to a good place- don't leave them alone in their troubles.



Materials:

- Paper plate
- White paper
- Markers
- Glitter
- Puffballs
- Glue
- Sequins



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut two rectangular holes in the middle of a paper plate right next to each other.
3. Have them decorate their plate however they wish. Make it shiny, make it sparkly, make it your own!
4. Have them write the numbers from 1-10 on a piece of paper to thread through the holes in the middle. Leave extra paper on either side of the numbers to pull through.
5. When the glue dries, thread the paper through the holes so that it is a countdown clock!
