NEW YEARS FIREWORKS

Lesson of the Day:

A new year gives us a blank slate- a perfect chance to make our mark. Cover your year with kindness and see what other kinds of beautiful things that kindness brings into your life!



Materials:

- Canvas
- Paint
- Glitter glue



• Toilet paper rolls

Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students paint the entire canvas black or dark blue.
- 3. Put the paint on the paper plates and cut the toilet paper rolls up from the bottom to leave strips (like a grass skirt at the bottom).
- 4. Dip the bottom of the toilet paper roll in the paint and put it onto the canvas. Have students do it as many times as they'd like, with a variety of colors.
- 5. Once the paint as dried, allow students to use glitter glue to add depth and shimmer to their fireworks.
- 6. Have students paint on a word of what they want to be this year: Kind, Caring, Honest, etc.
