



# NEW YEARS FIREWORKS

## Lesson of the Day:

A new year gives us a blank slate- a perfect chance to make our mark. Cover your year with kindness and see what other kinds of beautiful things that kindness brings into your life!



## Materials:

- Canvas
- Paint
- Glitter glue
- Toilet paper rolls
- Scissors



## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students paint the entire canvas black or dark blue.
3. Put the paint on the paper plates and cut the toilet paper rolls up from the bottom to leave strips (like a grass skirt at the bottom).
4. Dip the bottom of the toilet paper roll in the paint and put it onto the canvas. Have students do it as many times as they'd like, with a variety of colors.
5. Once the paint as dried, allow students to use glitter glue to add depth and shimmer to their fireworks.
6. Have students paint on a word of what they want to be this year: Kind, Caring, Honest, etc.
