

NEW YEAR'S EVE WAND

Lesson of the Day:

New Year's Resolutions are ways that we can remind ourselves to keep improving and being better people. But making the resolution isn't like having a magic wand- it doesn't happen just because we want it to. We have to keep it in mind and work hard to make those dreams reality.



Materials:

- Contact paper
- Glitter
- Sequins
- Scissors
- Paper

- Stick
- Glue
- Garland
- Markers



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut a star out of construction paper and write a New Year's Resolution around the outside. Have them stick it to the sticky side of the contact paper with the message facing the sticky side so it will be seen through the contact paper.
- 3. They can add glitter and sequins to the inside of the contact paper, where it should stick.
- 4. Have them cut the star out of the contact paper. Have them cut out another one for the other side, to stick it all together.
- 5. Put the stick against the inside before putting on the other side of the contact paper.
- 6. Have students wrap garland around the stick.
