

PAINTED STAR OF DAVID

Lesson of the Day:

We don't have to agree with everyone all the time. Different people believe different things. That doesn't mean that we can't still be friends with people who are different from us. In fact, often we can learn a lot more by being friends with people who are different from us. We can even learn to see the world a little bit differently.



Materials:

- Cardstock
- Paint

- Painter's tape
- Paintbrushes

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Tape a Star of David into the middle of a piece of cardstock using painter's tape.
- 3. Have students paint the paper however they want, using as many colors as they like.
- 4. Once the painting is done, remove the tape. There will be a Star of David left behind on the un-painted card stock.
