

PAPER AIRPLANES

Lesson of the Day:

Put good out into the world! Make sure that you are acting and speaking with kindness and if that's what you are putting out to those around you, the world will be a better place. If we all put love and kindness out into the world then the whole world would be a safe place for everyone.



Materials:

- Paper
- Markers/crayons/colored pencils

Instructions:



- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Brainstorm a list of ideas and words of kindness and friendship, compliments, nice things to tell people, etc.
- 3. Have them decorate their paper with these words, also drawing pictures and coloring nice patterns.
- 4. Have them follow a pattern for making a paper airplane. There are dozens online. Fold them together as a class, stepby-step. They can help people who sit next to them if their friends need help and they know what they are doing.
- 5. Fly the airplanes around the class! You can even fly them outside if it's dry.
