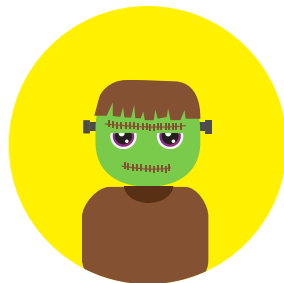




STUFFED BAG FRANKENSTEIN

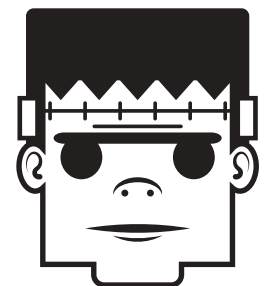
Lesson of the Day:

Even though he may look scary on the outside, he can still be a nice, warm friend! Frankenstein's monster was just misunderstood- he wasn't a monster, he was just lonely! Make friends with people no matter what they look like!



Materials:

- Paper bag
- Markers
- Google eyes
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Newspaper
- Stapler
- Puffballs
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students color the bottom of both sides of the paper bag green, while coloring the top black.
3. Have students stuff the bag with newspaper and fold the top down, stapling it shut. Use scissors to cut the ends of his hair.
4. Have them cut out an eyebrow and a nose and glue them to their bag along with their google eyes. Have them draw his mouth and scars.
5. Have students glue puffballs to his neck to act as the bolts.
