

PAPER BAG GIRAFFE

Lesson of the Day:

Don't be afraid to stand up tall and be brave. Stand up for others. Sometimes it can be scary to stick our necks out for someone. We are risking people making fun of us too. But if we all stand up to people who are being mean, they can't be mean to all of us. Stand up together!





Materials:

- Paper bag
- Yellow paint
- Brown paint
- Googly eyes
- Construction paper
- Markers

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students paint their paper bags yellow with brown spots.
- 3. While the bags start to dry, have students cut out the ears, mouth, and horns of the giraffe. Have them color and draw on these as needed.
- 4. Glue all the part of the paper bag together.
- 5. Add googly eyes.
