

PAPER BAG JELLYFISH

Lesson of the Day:

Sometimes jellyfish are almost see-through or they are the same color as the stuff around them. It can be really hard to see them. It can also be really hard to see when people are sad or angry. Still, we have to do our best to see what people around us are going through and help them when we can.





Materials:

- Paper bag
- Markers
- Googly eyes
- Scissors (regular)
- Scissors (fun, patterned)

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students color the paper bags with markers to decorate their jellyfish.
- 3. Have them add googly eyes to the bottom of the bag where the face will be. They can also draw a mouth if they want.
- 4. Have students cut up the bottom of the bag to make stingers. Students can use regular scissors or the fun scissors that cut in different patterns.
