

PAPER BAG WITCH

Lesson of the Day:

Don't judge someone by what they look like on the outside! Just because someone looks like a witch, doesn't mean they are one. Just because someone is big doesn't mean they're scary or even tough. Just because someone is tiny and delicate doesn't mean they're fragile. Find out about the person within and you might find a surprise!



Materials:

- Paper lunch bag
- Construction paper
- Scissors

- Glue
- Markers
- Googly eyes

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Cut out the shape of a dress and a witch's hat from black construction paper and glue them in place on the paper bag. Leave space under the hat to add hair.
- 3. Cut thin strips of purple (or whatever color hair is desired) construction paper. Fold the ends accordion-style and pull them back apart to make the hair look curly or frizzy. Glue in place.
- 4. Use markers and other construction paper to add details to the hat, dress, and face. Glue on googly eyes.
