

PAPER BIRDS

Lesson of the Day:

Birds flock together! By finding a group of other birds to fly around with, they know that they can all work together to stay safe and be happy. Find your flock! Make friends and build a group. Allow others to join! It's always a good way to be happy and have help when you need it.



Materials:

- Construction paper
- Feathers
- Googly eyes

- Scissors
- Glue
- Optional: brad



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut out a bird shape (it's recommended that you trace one for them to cut out). Have them glue feathers to the tail and the wings.
- 3. Have students cut out feet and a beak from yellow, black, or orange construction paper.
- 4. Have them glue the beak, feet, and googly eyes to the bird.
- 5. You can also make the wings separate from the bird's body and attach them with a brad once the glue dries. That way they move and flap!
