

## PAPER BUTTERFLY RINGS

## Lesson of the Day:

What is special about butterflies? They are beautiful, yes, but also they can fly. If they couldn't fly but were just beautiful, they wouldn't be as special. What they can do is more important than what they look like. Remember that the same is true of people- who they are and what they do is more important than what they look like.



## **Materials:**

- Foam rings (can sub paper if necessary)
- Construction paper
- Markers
- Stapler
- Pipe cleaner
- Glitter glue



## **Instructions:**

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Either use foam rings, or make rings out of construction paper and staple them together. Have students cut out a small butterfly and color it.
- 3. Have students wrap a pipe cleaner around the butterfly to attach it to the ring and to create antennae.
- 4. Let them add decorations like glitter glue to make their rings even more special!
