



PAPER CHAIN DRAGON

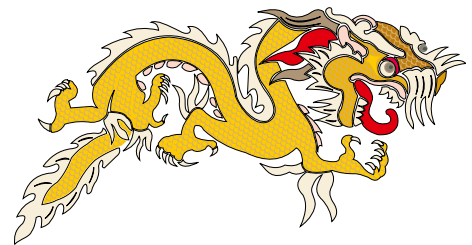
Lesson of the Day:

Many different cultures have stories about animals like dragons. Are dragons real? No! That means that we can make whatever kinds of stories about them that we want. We can be creative and use our imagination to make silly, funny, or scary stories. Should we make up fake stories about real people? No, it's not nice.



Materials:

- Colorful construction paper
- White paper
- Feathers
- Tape/stapler
- Scissors
- Black markers
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut construction paper into strips and make a multicolored paper chain.
3. Have students cut a large green oval and fold it to make the head, adding white circles and white triangles for eyes and teeth. Draw black in the eyes.
4. Have students fold a thin strip of red construction paper accordion style. Cut a triangle out of the end. Glue it inside the snake's mouth as a tongue.
5. Add feathers!
