

PAPER CROWNS

Lesson of the Day:

It's always nice to be a prince or princess or king or queen. But we can't always be in charge of everyone and be perfect at everything. But we all have something we are passionate about and good at. What are you the king or queen of? Appreciate when others at the queen or king and treat others with respect when it's your turn!



Materials:

- Construction paper
- Tape/stapler
- Markers
- Glitter glue

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Tape together two pieces of yellow construction paper. Have kids cut a crown-style edge at the top, however they want.
- 3. Have kids decorate the crown with glitter glue and any other decorations you have! Jewels and sequins can be lots of fun.
- 4. Once the glitter glue has dried, tape the crown around the kid's head so that it fits them.
