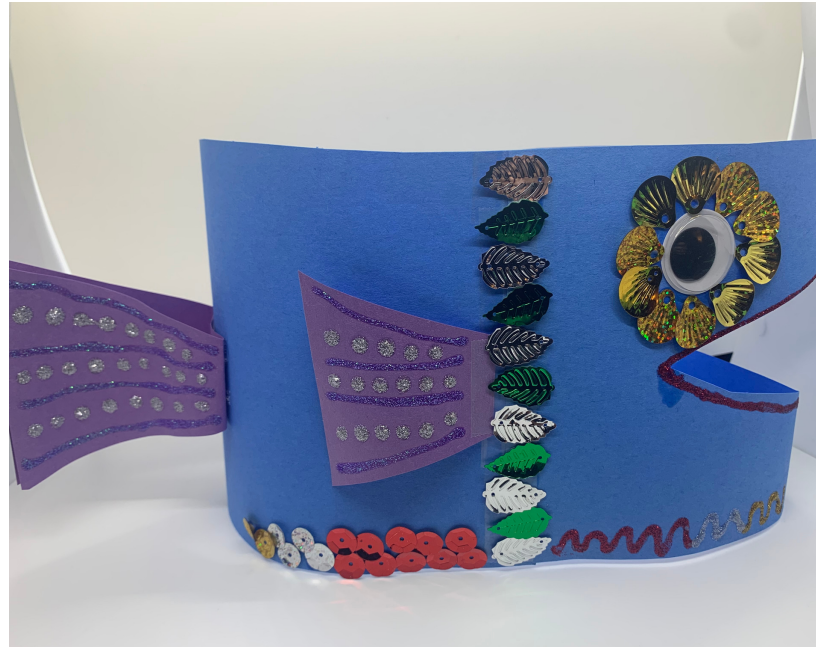




# PAPER FISH HATS

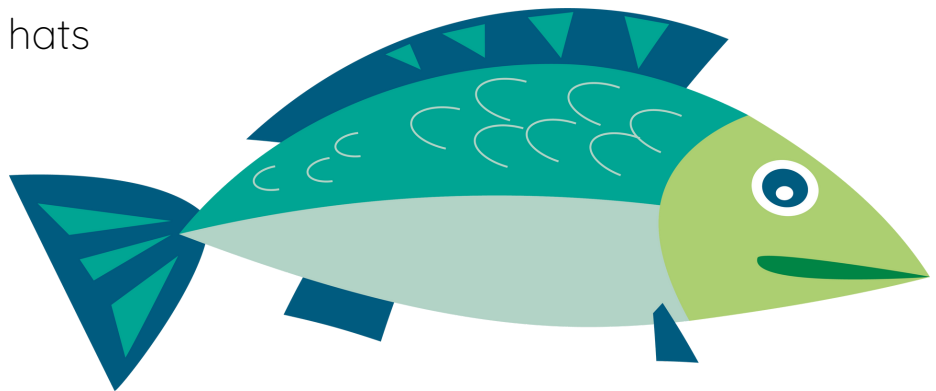
## Lesson of the Day:

There are a million different kinds of fish. What kinds of fish do you know? They come in all sizes, shapes, and colors. But they are all fish. The same is true of people: we come in all shapes, sizes, and colors, but we are all still human beings and have hearts. Take care of one another.



## Materials:

- Long paper for the hats
- Markers
- Sequins
- Glitter glue
- Stapler
- Googly eyes
- Glue



## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Staple the long paper together to make the main shape of the hat. Have students cut a triangle out for the mouth. That paper can be used as the tail.
3. Have students color their fish with whatever colors and pattern they would like- dots, stripes, whatever!
4. Cut out and staple on fins and a tail. Have them glue on googly eyes.
5. Let them add decorations like glitter glue or sequins to make their fish even more special!
