



PAPER HEART FLAMINGOS

Lesson of the Day:

Flamingos are very social birds- they live in large groups all together. This helps them stay safe, but it also helps make sure that they all work together to find enough food for everyone. They all share. If one flamingo in the group finds a lot of food, it doesn't keep it all for itself. It lets the rest of the group know so that everyone will have enough food.

We have to do that too! If you have extra of something, share it with someone in need! Take care of those around you.



Materials:

- Pink construction paper
- Pink pipe cleaners
- Pink feathers
- Small googly eyes
- Glitter glue
- Sequins
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut a heart out of pink construction paper. Have them cut and attach pipe cleaners for the neck and head, plus the legs.
3. Have students glue on feathers for the tail and construction paper for the face, adding a black beak and a small googly eye.
4. Let them add decorations like glitter glue or sequins to make their flamingos even more special!
