



PAPER ICE SKATES

Lesson of the Day:

It can be really hard to ice skate- a lot of times people fall down, especially when it's their first time. When people are trying something new, we should help them if we can. And if they fall, if they fail, we don't laugh. We help them back up.



Materials:

- White paper
- Hole punch
- Markers
- Popsicle stick
- Yarn
- Tape

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut two skate shapes out of paper. Make sure there are two long rectangles coming down from the bottom of the skate.
3. Have students color and decorate their skates.
4. Fold the rectangle around the popsicle stick and tape it together so the craft stick will stay.
5. Punch a hole at the top of each skate. Tie yarn through the holes so that the skates are connected.
