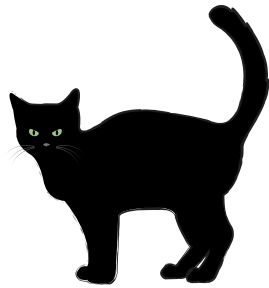




PAPER PLATE CAT

Lesson of the Day:

Cats are very picky about who they are friends with and who they let get close. They are even a little shy. What happens if you get too loud or excited and run toward a cat? They run away! We have to remember that with some people, we have to be gentle and calm if we want to be their friend. Some people are shy or anxious so we have to be extra kind.



Materials:

- Paper Plate
- Paper
- Black markers
- Pipe cleaner whiskers
- Glue
- Scissors
- Google eyes
- Puffball noses

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut their paper plate into a moon shape, using part of the edge of the plate as a tail. Also have them cut out a circle and two triangles from paper.
3. Have students color or paint the plate pieces and the paper.
4. Glue all the pieces together to resemble the cat in the picture.
5. Add pipe cleaner whiskers, google eyes, and a puffball nose to the cat's face.
