


PAPER PLATE DUCK

Lesson of the Day:

Ducks have special oil on their feathers that lets water roll right off of them. It's how they can swim AND fly. We have to remember to let some things roll off our backs too- don't let all the bad things get you down. If someone is being mean, don't take what they're saying to heart. It can be hard to do alone, so find a friend! When they're having a hard time be kind to them, and they'll do the same for you!



Materials:

- Small paper plate
- Orange and yellow paper Glue
- Markers
- Googly eyes

Instructions:

- Yellow feathers
- Scissors
- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut their paper plate in half and color it yellow.
- 3. Have them cut out a beak and feet from the orange construction paper and a head from the yellow.
- 4. Have them glue the head and feet to the plate body and the beak to the head.
- 5. Have them glue the yellow feathers on for a wing and tail, or more!
- 6. Once they add the googly eye, they'll have an adorable duck!
