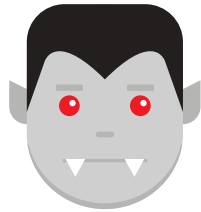




# PAPER PLATE HALLOWEEN CHARACTERS

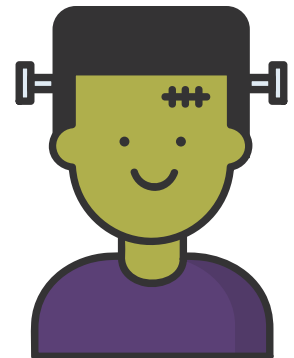
## Lesson of the Day:

There are lots of scary things around on Halloween! It's okay to be scared. Sometimes people in our lives feel scary to us, even if they haven't done anything to hurt us or anyone else. Maybe they're just big, or loud. Scary isn't always bad- sometimes it's just a misunderstanding. Give people a chance to show you if they are good or bad.



## Materials:

- Paper Plate
- Markers
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Paint
- Tissue paper
- Glue



## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Give each student their paper plate and encourage them to think through what character they want to do first. If a spider, they have to cut out the center of the paper plate, for example.
3. Allow students to use paint and tissue paper to make their Halloween character. They can also cut out construction paper to make certain parts of the character, like a bow tie or ears.
