

# PAPER PLATE SHEEP MASK

## Lesson of the Day:

Sheep tend to stay in a flock- a big group all together to keep safe. It's areat to have friends who have your back. If you see someone without a flock, invite them to yours! It's always good to make new friends. But if you flock, your friends, are doing something bad, it's okay to go your own way. You don't always have to follow!



### **Materials:**

- Cotton balls
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paper plate
  Black construction paper
  - Craft stick

### Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them
- 2. Have students cut a hole in the center of a paper plate. It's easier if they fold the plate in half and cut it that way.
- 3. Have students glue cotton balls around the remaining paper plate circle.
- 4. Have students cut two large ovals from black construction paper. You can pre-trace these to make it easier if they need it.
- 5. Have them glue the ears to the back of the paper plate.
- 6. Help them glue the paper plate to the popsicle stick. It may need hot glue depending on how long you want to allow for drying.
