


PAPER PLATE SNAIL

Lesson of the Day:

You can make your wishes and dreams come through with your own two hands. Don't wait for others to do it for you or rely on other people. You can do it yourself! If you need help, don't hesitate to ask, but you have the power to make things happen and make your own dreams come true.



Materials:

- Small paper plate
- Markers
- Beads

- Paper
- Pipe cleaners
- Googly eyes

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students color the paper plate to decorate it, then glue down beads in a swirl pattern.
- 3. While that starts to dry, have students cut out and color the snail's body. Hot glue the eyeballs to the pipe cleaners and help students affix them to the body.
- 4. Have students glue the two pieces together!
