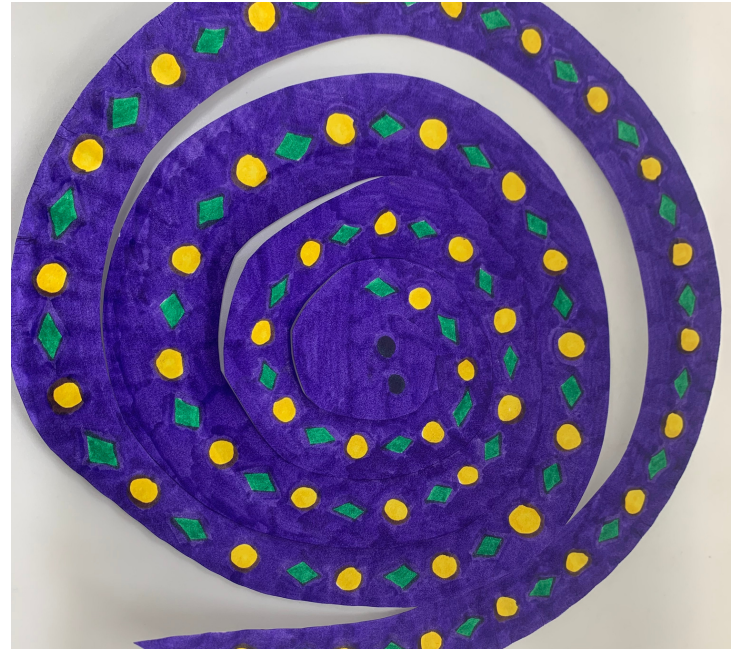




# PAPER PLATE TWISTY SNAKE

## Lesson of the Day:

Snakes are usually seen as being evil or scary, but they also shed their skin. Don't judge a book by its cover. Their cover might not be forever or an accurate representation of what is within. A person's heart is more important than what they look like on the surface.



## Materials:

- Paper plate
- Markers
- Scissors



## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut their paper plate in a spiral pattern. Draw the cutting line onto the paper plates beforehand if you think your students will need the guide.
3. Have students color their paper plate. Their snake can have any pattern they want.
4. Hang them around the room.
