

## PAPER PLATE TWISTY SNAKE

## Lesson of the Day:

Snakes are usually seen as being evil or scary, but they also shed their skin. Don't judge a book by it's cover. Their cover might not be forever or an accurate representation of what is within. A person's heart is more important than what they look like on the surface.



## **Materials:**

- Paper plate
- Markers
- Scissors



## Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut their paper plate in a spiral pattern. Draw the cutting line onto the paper plates beforehand if you think your students will need the guide.
- 3. Have students color their paper plate. Their snake can have any pattern they want.
- 4. Hang them around the room.
