



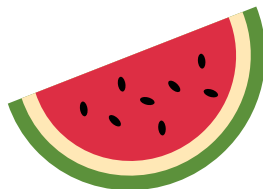
PAPER PLATE WATERMELONS

Lesson of the Day:

A watermelon is a huge fruit that no one person could eat all by themselves. Who would you share a watermelon with? Why is sharing important? How do people feel when you share with them?

Materials:

- Paper plate
- Paintbrushes
- Paint (green, red/pink, black)
- Hot glue
- Craft sticks



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut paper plates in half and share with a friend.
3. Have them paint their paper plate half to resemble a watermelon. Remind them to think of the right size of paintbrush and not only the color of the paint.
4. Hot glue the watermelon to a craft stick if desired.
