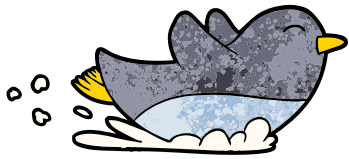




# PAPER PLATE PENGUIN

## Lesson of the Day:

Penguins aren't like other birds—even though they have wings they can't fly. But they can do all sorts of other things that other birds can't do, like swim! Don't focus on the things that you can't do, focus on the wonderful things you can!



## Materials:

- Paper plate
- Black markers
- Orange construction paper
- Hole puncher
- Black and white paper
- Glue

## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut a medium-sized hole toward the bottom of their paper plate. Punch holes all the way around the hole.
3. Have students color their paper plate black. Then have them weave white yarn around the hole.
4. Have students cut out heart shaped feet and a triangle beak from orange construction paper. Have them also cut out two wings from black construction paper and two eyes from white construction paper. Color a black circle inside the eyes. Have the students glue everything in place to make their penguin. Add details and decorations!
