PASTA CATS IN THE HAT

Lesson of the Day:

Be creative! Pasta isn't just for eating! Think of new ways to use old things rather than throwing things out or wasting them. Next time you're about to throw something away, think about whether it is something you could use again or something someone else might need. Don't waste!



Materials:

- Clothespins
- Bow tie pasta
- Ziti pasta

Instructions:

- Red and white paint
- Red glitter
- Cat face cutouts
- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have the students paint the pasta- the bowtie all red with red glitter and the ziti with red and white stripes.
- 3. While those are drying, have students cut out the Cat in the Hat and glue it to the clothespin. Leave space at the top and bottom to glue on the pasta.
- 4. Have students color the clothespins the color of the Cat in the Hat's clothing.
- 5. Once the paint on the pasta is dry, glue them to the clothespin.

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
