



PEACE PLATES

Lesson of the Day:

Everyone wants for the world to be a place where everything is peaceful and no one fights. That starts with us choosing to be kind whenever we can, and to think about how other people must feel and what they must be thinking.

So be kind, don't fight, and always, always, always do your best to keep things peaceful.



Materials:

- Paper plates
- Painter's tape
- Paint
- Black markers
- Paintbrush



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students tape a peace sign onto the back of their paper plate with painter's tape. If their motor skills are not up to the task, pre-tape it for them.
3. Allow students to paint their plate however they would like, using many colors.
4. When they're done painting, remove the tape.
5. Once the paint has dried completely, use the black markers to outline the edges of the peace sign.

TEACHER HINT: If paint is too messy or time it tight, let them use markers!
