



PEOPLE PUPPETS

Lesson of the Day:

There are all different kinds of people and traditions in the world. Some people look different from us or eat different foods or wear different clothing. But does different mean that someone is right and someone is wrong! No! Different just means different. Try to understand others and respect them, even when they are different from you.



Materials:

- Paper
- Markers
- Popsicle sticks
- Scissors
- Glue
- Decorations



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Trace the outline of a person on a piece of paper. Give the person interesting, colorful clothing and a face and hair.
3. When your person is complete, cut them out carefully.
4. Glue your paper person to the popsicle stick to make a puppet of a person.
5. Make another puppet, and this time try to make them different from you! Maybe you make a girl and you're a boy. Or you make someone who likes to wear different colors and styles from you. Or who looks different from you. Be creative!
