



POPSICLE STICK MENORAH

Lesson of the Day:

We have to bring light to life. Sometimes when things are bad it can seem like everything around us is dark. We have to look for positives and find the people who love and care about us. Then we can let them help us light up our lives. We can also be that light for other people.



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks
- Markers
- Hot glue gun
- Construction paper
- Glitter glue
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students color nine popsicle sticks as candles and four more as the base of the menorah.
3. Have students draw and cut out nine candle flame shapes while the teacher hot glues the menorah and candles together.
4. Have students glue their candle flames to the tip of the candles.
5. Students can then add gold glitter glue to make the candle flames look like they are really burning.
