



POPSICLE STICK ORNAMENTS

Lesson of the Day:

We can do little things every day to make life more fun, lively, and beautiful. With just a little bit of effort, we can make things better.

Try to find the ways you can do it, no matter how small they seem. Make a craft, share a toy, give a gift, help a friend. Little things can add up to make a big difference.



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks
- Hot glue and gun
- Markers
- Colored pencils
- Decorations
- String/ribbon



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Hot glue popsicle sticks together in the various shapes. The flat snowman and Santa shapes can be made by cutting a popsicle stick and hot gluing more popsicle sticks to it. You can do one small piece at the top and bottom. Hot glue a loop of string or ribbon to the top that the ornament will be hung by.
3. Have students color the popsicle sticks however they would like.
4. Allow them to add decorations- the hats, scarves, ornaments, star, etc.
5. The ornaments don't have to be just like the ones in the photo, or even Christmas related. Let students design and decorate however they want!
