

POPSICLE STICK RAINBOWS

Lesson of the Day:

You can't have a rainbow without rain! Sometimes the sadder, harder things in life help us to truly appreciate the beautiful, good things we have.



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks (6 per student)
- Glue
- Hot Glue



- White paper
- Markers
- Goggle eyes

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students color the six popsicle sticks each color of the rainbow (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple). One stick should be colored completely in each color.
- 3. Hot glue half a popsicle stick to the top of the back and the bottom of the back of the popsicle sticks after the students have arranged them in the proper color order.
- 4. While you are hot gluing, students will draw and cut out a cloud, adding a face and gluing on google eyes when they have cut it out.
- 5. Have students glue the cloud to the top of the popsicle sticks.
