

Lesson of the Day:

There are many different ways to look at the same person. Sometimes we know them well and know all the details- good and bad. Other times, we only know an outline or a silhouette of who they are. It's important to try and learn as much as we can about people to find things we have in common and ways we can befriend them or help them.



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks
- Hot glue gun
- Colored pencils

- Black/White markers/paint pen
- White/Black paint
- Small paintbrush

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Give each kid a popsicle stick canvas (popsicle stick that are held together by hot gluing a popsicle stick or half a popsicle stick to the back of the stack).
- 3. Have each kid color a background on their popsicle sticks however they would like. It's often good to have them use sky colors, but they can get more creative.
- 4. Have students draw a silhouette however they like over the top of the colored pencil background.
- 5. Allow them to add white paint or black paint for emphasis or to make the silhouette.
