

Q-TIP EASTER EGGS

Lesson of the Day:

When we do a craft, sometimes everyone's will look different because everyone has different ideas and is creative in different ways. As long as you go slowly and take your time, you can bring your idea to life and make it look wonderful.



Materials:

- Q-Tips
- White paper
- Scissors

- Paint
- Construction paper

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Draw multiple egg shapes on each page in whatever size you would like for your students to paint. It can help to make something for you to trace first to keep everything even.
- 3. Give students the paper with multiple egg shapes on it, along with several colors of paint and Q-tips.
- 4. Have students paint the eggs however they would like, with colors and patterns. The brighter and more fun, the better!
- 5. Once they dry, write the students' names on the back of each egg and have them cut the eggs out.
- 6. Glue to construction paper or use to decorate your room if you want!
