



# Q-TIP PAINTED TREES

## Lesson of the Day:

Even the tiniest things can all add up to make something big. If a lot of people do small little things to help make someone's life better, it can add up to a big change.



## Materials:

- Colored pencils/Markers
- Q-Tips
- Red paint
- Orange paint
- Yellow paint
- Brown paint

## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students color the background of their tree picture (grass and sky) using colored pencils or markers.
3. Have students paint a tree trunk and branches.
4. Using Q-Tips, have students make tiny dots of leaves on their tree. They can use many different fall colors, from brown, to red, to orange, to yellow.
5. Remind students that leaves during the fall do just that- fall. They should include some leaves falling off the tree and even more on the ground.
