

## **RAINBOW FISH**

## Lesson of the Day:

Read the book <u>The Rainbow</u> <u>Fish</u>. Discuss how the Rainbow Fish helped his friends. Rather than look at everyone like he was better than them, he helped them to feel special about themselves. Help your friends find what's special about them!



## **Materials:**

- Paper plate
- Tissue paper
- Paint
- White paper

- Scissors
- Glue
- Tin Foil
- Sponges



## Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have the students cut a triangle out of the paper plate and glue it to the back of the fish as his fin.
- 3. Have the students cut scales out of tissue paper and tin foil.
- 4. Have the students cut out an eye from white paper and draw a black circle on the inside of the eye.
- 5. Have the students paint the paper plate in varying shades of blue using sponges.
- 6. Stick the scales to the paint when possible, or use glue when the paint is no longer wet enough to stick to.
