## SHARP TOOTHED SHARK HATS

## Lesson of the Day:


Even scary things like sharks aren't always so bad. Sometimes if you look beneath the surface of a classmate who scares you, you'll see that on the inside, they're scared too. Everybody has a heart, even if their teeth can hurt.



## Materials:

- Blue construction paper
- White paper
- Black construction paper

## Instructions:



- Black markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Cut large, somewhat rounded triangles from blue construction paper.
- 3. Make a strip of paper to go around each student's head.
- 4. Have students decorate the large triangles to have a shark faceglue down a large piece of black construction paper as the mouth and draw eyes.
- 5. Have students cut many small white triangles and glue them around the outside of the black mouth, with the triangle points pointing toward the inside as teeth.
- 6. Affix the shark head to the headband paper strip.
