

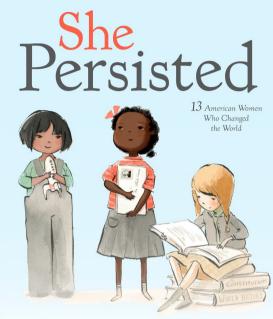
SHE PERSISTED CHELSEA CLINTON
