


SNAKE PAPER CHAIN

Lesson of the Day:

What is a body part that snakes don't have? They don't have any arms or legs! Would it be easy to live your life without arms and legs? No, it wouldn't be possible to live like we do without our arms and legs. But snakes find a way!


Sometimes we don't have the things we need to do what we want. But we can come up with creative ways to get things done. And if we see someone who needs something we have, we can help them out.



Materials:

- Construction paper
- Markers
- Glue

- Tape
- Googly eyes
- Scissors



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut and decorate strip of paper in various colors. Snakes come in many different colors and patterns, so they can make whatever pattern they want.
- 3. Have students make a paper chain with these decorated strips using tape. Have them add a point to the end of the tail. Have them add a head with googly eyes and a red tongue.
