

SNOWY TREES

Lesson of the Day:

Sometimes things change. Spring turns into summer, which becomes fall and then winter.

When things change it can be scary, and it can seem like the new thing isn't right. But give it time and look for the positives. For example, winter may be cold, but we also get to play in the snow!



Materials:

- Tree template
- Markers
- White paint
- Q-Tips

- White glitter
- Silver glitter
- White glitter glue
- Silver glitter glue

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students color the tree from this template either brown or black. Have them also color a surrounding picture.
- 3. Give students white paint to use for finger painting snow onto the ground and the trees.
- 4. Students can also use Q-tips to paint snow falling from the sky.
- 5. Once the paint has dried, students can add small amounts of white or silver glitter or glitter glue.
