

MONSTER PUPPETS

Lesson of the Day:

Symmetry is when things are the same on both sides, like a butterfly's wings. We want to have symmetry in how we treat people: we want to treat everyone with kindness no matter what they look like or how they are different from us. Always be kind!



Materials:

- Paint
- Construction paper
- Craft sticks
- Markers

- Googly eyes
- Glue
- Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students paint on half of a piece of paper however they want. Make sure they paint a little bit thickly. If the paint is too thin it won't transfer.
- Have students fold the paper in half and press down, transferring the paint from one side of the paper to the other. Let them fill in any gaps or spots where the paint didn't transfer.
- 4. Let those papers dry completely. Once they are dry, let students fold the paper in half again and cut out their monster's body shape. Then have them open the paper and add detailsconstruction paper hair, arms, and legs, googly eyes, etc.
- 5. Glue the monsters to a craft stick.
