



TISSUE PAPER KITE

Lesson of the Day:

Let your true colors fly! Don't be too shy and keep who you are and all the wonderful things about you a secret! Be yourself and don't be afraid. When you see other people being themselves, don't make fun of them, even if what they like may seem silly. Be kind and appreciate their bravery for putting themselves out there!

Materials:

- Colorful cardstock
- Hot Glue gun
- Ribbon
- Tissue paper
- Contact paper
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students work together to put small tissue paper squares onto a large piece of contact paper. When the whole part of the contact paper is covered, place another piece of contact paper over the top to seal it up and keep it flat.
3. Have students cut a kite shape out of colorful cardstock. While they do that, cut the contact and tissue paper into the same shape as the kite.
4. Glue the cardstock to the contact paper to make a beautiful kite.
5. Make a loop of ribbon to glue to the top and glue a long strip of ribbon to the bottom as well.
6. Have students cut out bow tie shapes and glue them to the ribbon.
