TISSUE PAPER MOSAIC BOOKMARKS

Lesson of the Day:

Try your best to read all kinds of different things! If you're still learning to read, have confidence! You will learn to do it well one day. If you know how to read, keep doing it! Pay attention to characters in the stories or people that you are reading about. How are they the same as you? How are they different?

Materials:

- Cardstock
- Tissue paper
- Glue
- Scissors

- Hole punch
- Ribbon/yarn
- Paintbrushes
- Bowls

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Give each student a cardstock bookmark.
- 3. Allow students to use paintbrushes to dip into bowls full of glue to stick tissue paper onto the bookmark. Tell them not to worry about the edges of the bookmark- if the tissue paper goes over the edge it's okay.
- 4. After the bookmark is covered and the glue has dried, cut the excess tissue paper off the edge.
- 5. Punch a hole at the top and tie a ribbon or yarn to stick out of the top of the book.
