



TOILET ROLL BATS

Lesson of the Day:

Bats have a lot in common with birds, but they're not the same. Our differences are what make the world beautiful and interesting, but our similarities are what really matter. By finding even just one thing in common with someone you can find a friend!



Materials:

- Black construction paper
- Toilet paper roll
- Tape
- Scissors
- White paper
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have each student wrap black construction paper around a toilet paper roll, taping it into place and cutting off any excess paper.
3. Have students cut out large black circles and cut them in half. Teach them how to accordion fold those half circles. Tape them to the back of the toilet paper roll as wings.
4. Have students cut out black and white triangles and attach them as ears and teeth. Have them glue on the googly eyes
