

TOILET ROLL FISH

Lesson of the Day:

Do fish swim around by themselves, or do they swim together? They swim together in groups called "schools". We're in a school too, and we're also all together in a group! Groups always work best when people are kind and work together.



Materials:

- Toilet rolls
- Tissue paper, various colors
- Glue
- Scissors
- String
- White paper
- Black markers

Instructions:



- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut tissue paper into scale shapes. Have them glue the scales down starting from the bottom.
- 3. Have students add strips of tissue paper to the bottom as a tail.
- 4. Have students cut out a white circle and paint a black circle inside for an eyeball. Tape string to the inside of the fish's "mouth" and hang them around the room as a bright, beautiful decoration!
