TOILET ROLL MERMAIDS

Lesson of the Day:

Materials:

- Toilet Roll
- Construction Paper
- Glue
- Scissors

- Markers
- Glitter Glue
- Paint
- Paint Brush



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students paint the toilet rolls in skin colors.
- 3. While the paint dries, have students cut the construction paper to make a mermaid tail, a strip of green that goes all the way around, hair, and a shell top. Encourage them to draw patterns with markers and decorate with glitter glue.
- 4. Help students glue the construction paper parts to the toilet paper roll.
- 5. With markers, have students draw a face and other decorations for the mermaid.
