

TOILET ROLL MONSTERS

Lesson of the Day:

Don't judge a book by it's cover! Monsters still have feelings.

Maybe the only reason they are monsters is that someone hurt them and made them be that way. Be kind to everyone, even if they are not always kind, and you may find a new friend! Sometimes people put up walls to keep their warm heart safe on the inside.



Materials:

- Toilet paper/paper towel roll
- Construction paper
- Tape
- Glue

- Markers
- Google eyes
- Scissors



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Students can cut their toilet paper or paper towel roll to the size they want their monster to be-tall, medium, or short.
- 3. Allow students to select the color they want their monster to be. They can then wrap and cut construction paper to fit around their toilet paper roll.
- 4. Students can now add details with markers, construction paper, and googly eyes. They can add mouths, noses, and hair.
