Lesson of the Day:

Join together! Be a part of the group! When you are a part of a group, whether it's a classroom, a group of friends, or a family, you have to contribute something to help everyone else out. What do you want to contribute? Do you want to be helpful? Do you want to be kind? If you're both, you'll find that there are a lot of groups you can belong to!



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks
- Hot glue
- Markers
- Goggle eyes
- White paper
- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Glue six popsicle sticks together with hot glue, placing half a popsicle stick across the top and the bottom of the backside of the popsicle sticks. Glue another popsicle stick across the top, crooked, about an inch and a half down.
3. Have students color the crossways popsicle stick dark blue. Above this stick, have them color the sticks red or painted white, alternating.
4. Have students trace their hands on white paper, cutting them out carefully. They should glue them to the bottom.
5. Have them add a mouth and glue on googly eyes.
