



VALENTINE DONUT

Lesson of the Day:

It's important to tell people how we feel about them. If you don't tell someone and show someone you love them or care about them, how will they know? If you tell them or show them you love them, how will that make them feel? How do you feel when people tell you they love you? Do you want to make others feel that way?



Materials:

- Scissors
- Cardstock
- Markers and colored pencils
- Decorations (glitter glue, confetti, paper hearts)
- Googly eyes

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students fold a piece of paper in half and draw a circle from the folded line. They should cut it out, leaving part of the folded center connected.
3. Have students color in their donuts and write a Valentines message
4. Have students glue decorations onto the donut to look like sprinkles.
5. Have students add googly eyes and a smile
6. Tell them to give it to someone they love!
